CONDITIONS *of* ACCEPTANCE

By taking part in the GB Rally 2010, your team agrees to:

- Pay an entry fee of £400 per person (driver plus navigator). In addition, each team shall raise a minimum of £750 in sponsorship.
- Pay the Oracle Cancer Trust a deposit of £350 on or before 1st August 2010. Remaining entry fee and sponsorship to be paid by 13th September 2010.
- Present your car in a safe and roadworthy condition and ensure that every driver and passenger in the team is aged 18 years or over, all drivers hold a valid full driving licence and that the vehicle is fully taxed, insured and holds an up to date MOT Certificate.
- Carry a minimum of one mobile phone so that you can be contacted at all times.
- Complete the course between Goodwood and Bath within the specified timescale to qualify for an award category.
- The Oracle Cancer Trust will be the sole beneficiary of any sponsorship raised through competing in the event.
- Cancellations and refunds minus a £250 administration fee can only be made before 09.30 on Tuesday 7th September 2010. We regret that refunds are not available for non-starters after this time.
- Teams that are unable to participate for any reason must offer to return any sponsorship monies collected to the sponsors. Should the sponsors agree that the monies might be donated to the Oracle Cancer Trust in any event, the sponsors must countersign the sponsorship form to confirm their agreement, and this money must then be paid to the Oracle Cancer Trust.
- Oracle Cancer Trust or the event organisers, Shaun Gay Associates, reserve the right to refuse entry to any participant.
